

### FACULTY OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The Faculty of Business Administration (FBA) at the University of New Brunswick in Fredericton invites applications for a tenure-track position in Finance. The appointment will be at the rank of Assistant Professor. The appointment will be with effect from July 1, 2018, or as soon thereafter as possible. This position is subject to final budgetary approval.

The successful applicant will have a PhD or DBA in Finance in hand (or be nearing completion) at the time of appointment. Preference will be given to applicants who also hold a relevant professional industry designation such as a CFA.

The successful candidate must have a demonstrated record of excellence in university teaching and research or evidence of the ability to develop such a record. Teaching assignments will be at the undergraduate and post graduate level and may include courses in the areas of corporate finance, investments, fixed income, mergers and acquisitions, and international financial management.

The FBA has strategic industry and community partnerships including a long-standing partnership between its Centre for Financial Studies and Vestcor Investment Management Corporation (formerly the New Brunswick Investment Management Corporation) through which we offer a highly successful experiential elective full-year course on investments. A new graduate program, Master of Quantitative Investment Management, has been developed in consultation with Vestcor and is expected to be launched in 2018. The FBA is innovative in its programs, curriculum design and outreach activities and has more than 840 students in the undergraduate program and 100 students in the current graduate program. In addition to the domestic programs, the FBA also offers its programs in partnership with an institution in Trinidad and Tobago.
