The Department of Management at the University of Toronto Scarborough, invites applications from qualified candidates for a full-time, tenure stream appointment in Finance. The appointment will be at the rank of Assistant Professor with an expected start date of July 1, 2021, or shortly thereafter.

Applicants must have a PhD degree in Finance or Economics, or a closely related area, by the time of appointment or shortly thereafter, with a demonstrated record of excellence in research and teaching. We seek candidates whose research and teaching interests complement and strengthen our existing [departmental strengths](#). The successful candidate will be expected to pursue innovative and independent research at the highest international level and to establish an outstanding, competitive, and externally funded research program.

Candidates must provide evidence of research excellence which can be demonstrated by publications in top-ranked and field relevant journals and/or high-quality working papers, the submitted research statement, presentations at significant conferences, awards and accolades, and strong endorsements from referees of high standing.

Evidence of excellence in teaching will be provided through teaching accomplishments, the teaching dossier including a teaching statement, sample course materials, and teaching evaluations submitted as part of the application. Candidates must also show evidence of a commitment to equity, diversity, inclusion, and the promotion of a respectful and collegial learning and working environment demonstrated through the application materials.

The successful candidate will be a member of the tri-campus Graduate Department of Management at the University of Toronto, will be cross-appointed to the Rotman School of Management and will be expected to participate in the Graduate Department of Management's graduate programs.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
